



Using public transport

From the Antwerp Berchem train station (± 10 minutes on foot):

- Exit the station from the track 10 side. Cross the intersection to the opposite corner.
- Climb the stairs and take the first street left (Boomgaardstraat).
- Follow this winding street until you reach Waterfordstraat, then turn left.
- Carry on down this street, which changes name a couple of times - first Eikelstraat and then Belpairestraat.
- Just before the grass plot, turn right into Coveliersstraat.

From Antwerp Central Station (± 10 min by tram):

Take the escalator to the premetro and take tram 15 in the direction of Mortsel. Get off at the 'de Merode' stop (at Campo & Campo galleries) then proceed on foot in the same direction as the tram you just left and take the first street left (Belpairestraat). Take the first left after that, being Coveliersstraat.

By car:

From Brussels

- After the Craeybeckxtunnel (in the direction of the ring road), follow the sign "Centrum" and take the Generaal Lemanstraat (N155).
- When you reach the Albert Park, turn right into Prins Albertlei.
- Follow Boomgaardstraat and take the first street to the right, which is Coveliersstraat.

From the Netherlands, Hasselt, etc.

- Leave the ring road on exit no. 4 to Berchem and take Grote Steenweg in the direction of "Centrum".
- At "Brouwerij De Koninck" turn right into Boomgaardstraat.
- Then take the first street right, which is Coveliersstraat.



From Ghent

- Leave the ring road on exit no. 5 to Berchem and follow the signs towards "Centrum".
- This will take you to Generaal Lemanstraat (N155), turn left towards "Centrum".
- When you reach Albert Park, turn right into Prins Albertlei.
- Follow Boomgaardstraat and take the first street to the right, which is Coveliersstraat.

If you want to park in the underground parking lot, then take the third street right in Boomgaardstraat (instead of the first right) and onto Sint-Lambertusstraat. Then take the first street right (Belpairestraat), in which the parking lot is located at no. 20.
